## The Love that Saves.

Acts 10:25-26,34-35,44-48, 1 John. 4:7-10, John 15:9-17 "Whoever loves me will keep my word, says the Lord, and my Father will love him and we will come to him".

The early Church grappled with the question of inclusion, particularly regarding the Gentiles. Amidst debates over circumcision and moral standards, Peter's visit to Cornelius illustrates a divine truth: God shows no partiality. Through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Gentiles, Peter emphatically proclaims the universality of acceptance into the faith community for all who fear God.

This issue resonates with contemporary moral dilemmas. Yet, the apostolic decision, rooted in God's inclusive love, remains instructive. The inclusive embrace does not negate the moral imperatives of Scripture. Salvation is offered to all, and it hinges on embracing Jesus' redemptive sacrifice and repenting from sin. James, in his counsel, reminds us that while all are welcome, adherence to God's commandments remains paramount. In a world where societal norms may diverge from divine truth, we are called to uphold the uncompromising love of God and revealed truth.

Jesus urges us to abide in His love through obedience. His commandment to love one another echoes His sacrificial love and is distinct from worldly notions. This divine love, exemplified by Christ's selflessness is our path to eternal life. John's epistle further elucidates this divine love, emphasizing that it is not our love for God, but His love for us, that initiates salvation. Our obedience to his command is our response to his invitation to be saved. "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends and you are my friends if you do what I command you."
